Emergency and First Aid Procedures

Eye Contact: Wash the affected eye or eyes under slowly running water for 15 minutes or longer making sure that the victim's eyelids are held wide apart and moves eye slowly in every direction.

Skin Contact: 1. Remove victim from source of contamination.
 2. Remove victim from source of affected area.
 3. Wash affected area under water shower.
 4. Rinse carefully
 5. If the skin is inflamed or painful, contact medical services.

Inhalation: 1. Make the victim blow his nose to remove the dust but discourage from sniffing.
 2. If there is any doubt about the victims condition send or escort to medical attention.

Ingestion 1. Make the victim vomit.
 2. After vomit give milk and water.
